Wikis

Everyone knows Wikipedia, which is written by its own users. In Blackboard you can create a course wiki where teachers and students can create and edit content connected to the course. This wiki is not accessible to the public.

The students can be given a variety of tasks in relation to the wiki, so the production of content for the wiki may result in the joint development of knowledge in the class.

This is what to do

- 1. Choose + in the top left-hand corner above the menu.
- 2. Add a Tool Link.
- 3. Give the wiki area a name, choose Wikis in the list and mark Available to Users.
- You can move the menu point up and down using the small arrow on the left.
- 5. Open the wiki area and choose Create Wiki.
- 6. Give the wiki a name and mark the required settings. Remember to give the students permission to take part.
- 7. Choose Submit.
- 8. Choose your wiki. You have now started to write your first entry in the wiki.
- 9. If you want to link between several entries in the wiki, you need to use the Wiki Icon on the right in the bottom line of the editor.
- 10. Mark the text you want to link from, choose the Wiki Icon and choose the article you want to link to.
