Padlet is a virtual bulletin board that you can share with others. The tool is free to use, and it is easy to share it via the web address or to embed it in Blackboard.

This is how you get started:

1) You must, as a teacher, sign up to use the service. You can access the free version on <u>www.padlet.com</u> or you can access the Aarhus University license by contacting your educational research center.

2) When you want to create a padlet click on the button

+ MAKE A PADLET


You can then choose between different templates.

You can either write texts and insert images and video on your bulletin board by double-clicking on the canvas.


3) When you have used the padlet, you have the option of "locking" it. When you lock a padlet, it cannot be changed afterwards. To lock the padlet, choose the icon labeled "share" in the upper right corner. Then, change the settings to "Can Read" in the tab **PEOPLE & PRIVACY**.



Viewing a Padlet on Blackboard -How to:

1) Before you imbed a padlet in Blackboard, you must first find the "Embed"-code on your bulletin board. Do this by following these steps:

Chose the button "share" and then "Share/Export/Embed". Next, chose "Embed your blog or website".



Next, name the project appropriately.



Then, click on the button labeled "HTML" in the editor, as you see in the image above. Insert the "Embed-code" that you copied from the padlet.

Click "Update", then "Submit" on the item-form. Now you can find the padlet embedded in your cours, all participant in the course will be able to access and write in the padlet.
