



Project placement Inspiration sheet for supervision after the internship

Using the inspiration sheet for questions the teacher may ask the student in their capacity of supervisor:

- The inspiration sheet is intended to encourage the student to consider the reflection questions below, which the supervisor presents and discusses with the student.
- The reflection sheet is the third of three handouts – one to be used before the internship begins, one during the internship and one after/towards the end of the internship.

3. Reflection questions **after/towards the end of the internship:**

- Have you identified, now or during the course of your internship, one or more academic issues that may form the basis of a topic for your thesis?
- When trying to identify a possible topic for your thesis, it may be helpful for you to consider the following:
 - Try to explain in words the potential you consider the issue to have as regards a possible thesis topic.
 - Consider the pros and cons as regards the interest- or career-related level. You may for instance make a list of the pros and cons.
 - What methodology do you prefer when working?
 - Are there particular theories you would like to implement in your thesis?
 - Are there particular issues that arouse your academic curiosity?
 - What academic issues are you most inclined towards?
