"TED Talk" videos

Dear Visual Analysts,

Together with the lecturer, I have selected seven texts from the compendium which might need to be communicated in a creative manner to create a clear overview. You may use any devices in your videos: backgrounds, posters, PP, subtitles, illustrations, role plays or whatever you might think of. You should communicate the essential points and concepts of the text and provide us, as your audience, with an idea of what the text or theory can be used for. Consider how you present – in other words, conduct a visual analysis of your effort. Record the video using what is available to you, e.g. a mobile phone camera.

The task is named after the TED Talk phenomenon because this *may* inspire your organisation of the video. Check their website for good ideas. Here are a few examples to start from. Each of them represents different communication strategies and visual expressions:
